She is manageable and has forgotten how to do many things and her memory has almost gone but she tries very hard to remember people and events because I try to push her. She doesn't want other unknown people around her and she walks twice a day mostly alone to a park nearby.

I have had only problems with Aged Care packages and I have now declined to have one. The money goes to them and my mother does not benefit.

I would suggest that in some cases like mine that the family member be the direct recipient of the funds allocated for the sole benefit of the parent.
